

Zoning Map Amendment

Mixed Use (M-X-T and M-X-C) Zones Required Findings, Section 27-213

- (a) Criteria for approval
 - (1) The District Council shall only place land in the M-X-T Zone if at least one of the following two criteria is met:
 - (A) Criterion 1. The entire tract is located within the vicinity of either:
 - (i) A major intersection or major interchange (being an intersection or interchange inwhich at least two of the streets forming the intersection or interchange are classified in the Master Plan as an arterial or higher classified street reasonably expected to be in place within the foreseeable future.
 - (ii) A major transit stop or station (reasonably expected to be in place within the fore-seeable future).
 - (B) Criterion 2. The applicable Master Plan recommends mixed land uses similar to thosepermitted in the M-X-T Zone.
 - (2) Prior to approval, the Council shall find that the proposed location will not substantially impair the integrity of an approved General Plan, Area Master Plan, or Functional Master Plan and is in keeping with the purposes of the M-X-T Zone. In approving the M-X-T Zone, the District Council may include guidelines to the Planning Board for its review of the Conceptual Site Plan.
 - (3) Adequate transportation facilities
 - (A) Prior to approval, the Council shall find that transportation facilities that are existing, are under construction, or for which 100 percent of construction funds are allocated within the adopted County Capital Improvement Program, within the current State Consolidated Transportation Program, or will be provided by the applicant, will be ad-equate to carry anticipated traffic for the proposed development.
 - (B) The finding by the Council of adequate transportation facilities at this time shall not prevent the Planning Board from later amending this finding during its review of sub-division plats.
