Summary of Questions and Answers and Slido Poll Responses

Question 2 (Q2)

Are you considering specific areas of Capitol Heights? If so, I know of several vacant properties that have been vacant for years.

Response to Q2

Only a portion of the Town of Capitol Heights is within the boundary of the plan area. As part of the planning process, we consider the land use and zoning for all properties including those that are vacant. We recognize the impact vacant properties can have in an area and see their potential for other uses.

Question 3 (Q3)

What's the status of Landover Mall land for sale and/or development?

Response to Q3

The Landover Mall site is outside of the plan area. It is part of the 2009 Approved Landover Gateway Sector Plan. The Landover Mall site is currently being considered for the future Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) headquarters. If not selected for the FBI headquarters, the property owner has indicated a data center may be built.

Question 4 (Q4)

Is the County's focus on the creation of a downtown Largo in the area of the new hospital along with the movement of the seat of government going to be detrimental to attracting desired intensity and density to the silver/blue line areas?

Response to Q4

We hope not. A unified vision for the local centers inside the Beltway should complement Largo Town Center by providing different live and work opportunities.

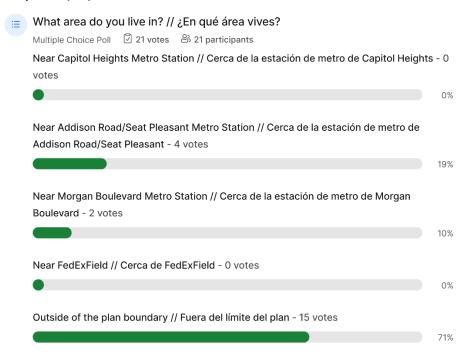

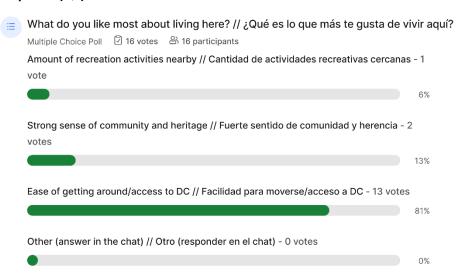

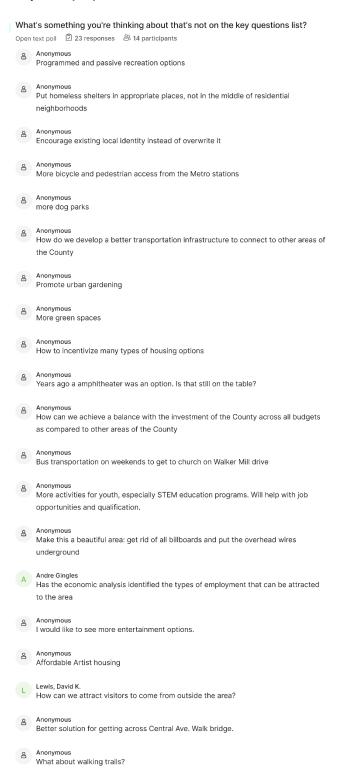
