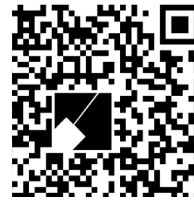

PROJECT STATEMENT

The Suitland Cultural Arts Implementation Strategy will build upon the Prince George's County Cultural Arts Study. Its primary objective is to identify ideal locations for creative placemaking. The Strategy will also craft conceptual designs tailored to each location's unique characteristics and community needs.

Over the next several months, the Planning Department will actively engage community members through a series of stakeholder interviews and design workshops. These workshops will serve as a platform for education, enlightening participants about the principles of placemaking and the power of cultural arts in fostering vibrant communities.

In addition to conceptualizing improvements, the Strategy will develop a maintenance plan. This plan will outline policies for the upkeep and utilization of the proposed improvements, ensuring their sustained benefit for the community over time.
