## Suitland Cultural Arts Implementation Strategy Community Design Charrette

The Prince George's County Planning Department and consultant firm Designing Local are hosting a **Suitland Cultural Arts Implementation Strategy Community Design Charrette**. This is an opportunity for residents to continue engaging in the process of identifying ways to center cultural arts in spaces around Suitland. These spaces include new and existing spaces where creative arts and placemaking projects can enhance the community.

**What is a charrette?** A charrette is a fast-paced, collaborative workshop where participants work intensively over a short period to develop innovative solutions. The goal is to create multiple ideas for group discussion and testing. The best ideas are refined into draft concepts, which lay the foundation for future design and planning work.

The charrette will occur over a series of days with community members invited to workshop with the design team. You may also be directly invited to an additional small group session with the design team for a specific site that may impact you and the community.
